A Big Thank You to the Senior Citizens for your donation to the activity department. You are appreciated.

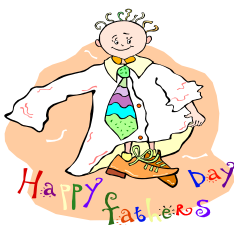
Thank You to Mary Lou and Mary Ellen for filling in for me so I could be out with my husband to the doctors. Again Thank You.
